Any agreed reserves will be clearly indicated on our presale entry forms/appraisal forms.

**Commission on goods is Up to £500 - 15% + VAT
Over £500 the commission is 10% + VAT
(Larger items may carry an entrance fee)**

Photographs may be taken of particularly interesting lots and will be published on our website and may be advertised locally.

After the auction, providing your items have sold, we will forward you a cheque (less our charges) after 7 days.

Any unsold items MUST be collected the following day of Auction between 9am-1pm.

Any items not collected and are left on the premises will incur storage charges.
